ramp. Also, the first two feet from the back of curb must be available for traffic control signage. WYDOT requires signs to be a minimum 7 foot height, and any items placed here by others requires a minimum 10' height (like awnings).

I asked about curb bulb-outs. WYDOT is responsible for all snow removal on the highways. Unless the Town wants to take on the responsibility of snow removal in the parking lane, she will not allow curb bulb-outs.

Snow removal - sidewalks. By state statute, the Town is responsible for snow removal on all sidewalks. The town can reassign the responsibility to adjacent land owners. Outside of city limits, WYDOT is responsible for snow removal on sidewalks. As such, Shelby will not place sidewalks outside of town without a cooperative maintenance agreement from the Town or other entity.

Crosswalks. Pedestrian traffic counts do not warrant crosswalks in Basin. WYDOT does not encourage the placement of crosswalks unless it is warranted. However, Basin can install them, but the Town would need to maintain them.
