Brief Summary

Committee members review and discuss public comments from the open house meetings.

Ken Markert presented the Land Suitability Analysis which indicates areas suitable for development or conservation and serves as the basis for the plan's future land use map.

Decisions/Action Items

- After reviewing the public comments on the proposed plan goals, the committee decided it would be useful for the consultants to prepare a summary of the discussion and committee consensus on each issue that was discussed.
 - The committee also asked that the goals be revised to reflect the discussion and consensus on issues. The committee will review the revised goals with the intent to finalize them at the next meeting.
 - The committee decided to request an opportunity to brief the county commissioners on the progress and direction of the plan following the next committee meeting.
 - The committee indicated its preference for a version of the Land Suitability Analysis that depicts the analysis for deeded land only.
