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Brief Summary

Committee members reviewed the May 2009 Draft of the land use plan and made changes in preparation for the open house meetings to be held in June.

Decisions/Action Items

The committee requested the following changes in the draft plan--these changes are to be included in the draft that will be available by June 1, 2009:

- New cover page
 - New page listing project participants
 - Minor additions to the table of contents
 - Change order of the words “require” vs. “authorize” in first paragraph under section 1.2 on page 1-2
 - Changed the title of the table on old page # 2-13 to DEFINITIONS OF THE FUTURE LAND USE MAP AREA TYPES instead of FUTURE LAND USE DESIGNATIONS
 - Added a new part on “Using the Future Land Use Map” starting on new page # 2-13 to explain how the map and definitions work together
 - Added a notation to all the future land use maps saying the definitions can be found in the draft plan and eliminating the word “designations” from the maps
 - Added the “groundwater overlay” to all the future land use maps (it was inadvertently left out of the previous maps)
 - Changed the all the text in part 2.3.1 to have “Revision of Current Regulations” ahead of “Potential New Regulatory Actions”
 - Similarly changed the order of the list (Potential Actions on old page # 2-20) to have “Revision of Current Regulations” ahead of “Potential New Regulatory Actions”
 - Similarly revised the “Goals Achievement Matrix” and Appendix C (PowerPoint Presentation) to have “Revision of Current Regulations” ahead of “Potential New Regulatory Actions”
 - Moved old page # 2-20 (Potential Actions list) to just ahead of the fold-out Goals Achievement Matrix” to have “Revision of Current Regulations” ahead of “Potential New Regulatory Actions”
 - Put a page-break at 2.3.1.3 Recommended Actions so the first 2 paragraphs of that section appear on the same page as the list of recommended actions.
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Next meeting dates will be:

- i. Open houses week of June 8. The three open house meetings are scheduled for June 9-11 in Lovell, Greybull, and Manderson.

- ii. Final meeting June 25th. The committee decided to hold its final meeting on Thursday, June 25th, at 7 pm, in Basin.
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Next Steps/Follow-up

- Consultants will revise the draft plan and post it on the project website by June 1, 2009.
 - Consultants will make all preparations for the open house meetings, including preparing a summary of the plan and a comment form. The consultants will also provide a presentation about the plan at the open houses.
