Brief Summary

Committee members met for the first time. They reviewed roles, responsibilities, process, and schedule.

Decisions/Action Items

1. Ken Markert will create a link on project Website to the state legal code for land use plans.
 2. Committee approved the "Roles and Responsibilities" document with the following change in item 7 (new wording underlined). "After the committee has reached an agreement about an item, the item will not be revised in later meetings unless agreed to by the majority."
 3. Per the suggestion of the County Commissioners, the Committee approved the addition of Nick Wilson, an engineer living in Cowley, as a member of the Committee.
 4. Committee decided Jim Waller will function as the official spokesperson for the Committee, with back-up support from consultants.
 5. Committee agreed the best way for the public to comment would be in writing (on paper or via email or website) or verbally at meetings.
 6. Committee decided consultants can keep the committee informed via email and by posting new materials on the website.
 7. Committee approved meeting schedule through May 2009. Will stick to fourth Thursday, 7:00 p.m., with location to rotate between north and south parts of the county. Frequency of rotation to be based on the proportion of north/south committee members, suggested currently that every 3rd or 4th meeting be held in the north. Next meeting will be in Basin.
 8. Committee members did not have any new items to add to the Survey results and agreed that key concepts were identified accurately.
